- Q. Can you recall who else was present at that August 22nd meeting at the Berghof, as nearly as you can?
- A. The Generals who were in charge?
- Q. We know who some of them were, but I would like to know what your memory is?
- A. General Reichenau; von Bock; General von Kessler, who, I believe, was stationed in East Prussia -I think he was there; I am sure General von Kluge -he was in charge of an Army --I believe he was a
  Lieutenant General; Brauchitsch, of course; von
  Halder; General Busch, from Breslau.
- Q. How many, roughly, would you say?
- A. General Strauss there were about 15 to 20 Generals present.
