

(Transcript of interrogation of Wilhelm Keitel, 28
August 1945, page 10.)

Q. Can you recall who else was present at that August
22nd meeting at the Berghof, as nearly as you can?

A. The Generals who were in charge?

Q. We know who some of them were, but I would like
to know what your memory is?

A. General Reichenau; von Bock; General von Kessler,
who, I believe, was stationed in East Prussia --
I think he was there; I am sure General von Kluge --
he was in charge of an Army -- I believe he was a
Lieutenant General; Brauchitsch, of course; von
Halder; General Busch, from Breslau.

Q. How many, roughly, would you say?

A. General Strauss - there were about 15 to 20 Generals
present.
