1. MEMEL	Lithuanian	2,557	154,700	22 March 1939. Ceded by treaty in violation of Versailles. Incorporated in Regierungsbezirk Gumbinnen, East Prussia.
2. DANZIG	Free City	1,893	390,400	1 Sept. 1939. Declares self part of Reich in violation of Versailles. Incorporated in new Gau Danzig-Westpreussen.
3. INCORPORATED EASTERN TERRITORY	Polish	91,075	10,043,000	24 Oct. 1939. Incorporated by decree after Polish capitulation.
4. SUWALKI		2,881	116,400	Incorporated in Regierungsbezirk Gumbinnen, East Prussia, as Landkreis Sudauen.
5. CIECHANOW		13,405	879,100	Organized as new Regierungsbezirk Ciechanow in East Prussia. Area of Druskiens (193) to. incl. 24,800 pop., incorporated in Regierungsbezirk Allenstein.
6. POLISH CORRIDOR		21,237	1,594,400	Combined with Danzig and sections of East Prussia into new Gau Danzig-Westpreussen.
7. POZNAN (Posen)		43,905	4,893,700	Organized as new Gau Wartheland.
8. POLISH SILESIA		10,587	2,768,400	Incorporated in Prussian Silesia, creating new Regierungsbezirk Katowitz.
9. EUPEN-HALMÈDY (including Moresnet)	Belgian	1,056	56,900	18 May 1940. Incorporated in Gau Köln-Aachen, in violation of Versailles; later included territory not German in 1919.
10. LUXEMBOURG	Independent State	2,585	206,900	Summer 1940. Not formally incorporated. Administered by Gauleiter of Moselland, Simon, in Koblenz.
11. ALSACE	French	8,300	1,219,400	Summer 1940. Not formally incorporated but virtually annexed in violation of IWC armistice. Administered by Wagner, Gauleiter and Reichstatthalter of Baden, from Straßburg.
12. LORRAINE	French	6,229	896,200	Summer 1940. Not formally incorporated but virtually annexed, in violation of IWC armistice. Administered by Bürckel, Gauleiter and Reichstatthalter of Westmark, from Saarbrücken.
13. LOWER STYRIA and UPPER CARNIOLA	Yugoslav	8,620	775,000	14 April 1941. No formal decree of annexation but virtually annexed by establishment of German civil administration. Lower Styria administered by Gauleiter of Styria (Steiermark), Überreinhard, but Dravaograd district incorporated in Gau Carinthia. Upper Carniola (Oberkrain) administered by Gauleiter of Carinthia (Kärntn), Raabe.
14. BIALYSTOK	Annexed by USSR in 1939. Previously Polish.	31,160	1,800,000	1 Aug. 1941. No formal decree of annexation published, but organized as Bezirk under administration of Provincial President of East Prussia, Erich Koch. From April 1942 he acted as Civil Administrator directly for the Reich.
15. CISALPINE TERRITORY	Italian	17,276	885,400	Sept-Oct. 1943. No formal decree of annexation, but provinces of Bolzano, Trentino, and Belluno combined into new unit called Alpenvorland under a high commissioner, Franz Hofer, Gauleiter of Tirol und Vorarlberg, in Innsbruck.
16. ADRIATIC LITTORAL	Italian provinces and Italian-annexed Yugoslav territory	16,000 (approx.)	1,300,000 (approx.)	Sept/Oct. 1943. No formal annexation, but Italian provinces of Udine, Gorizia, Trieste, Pula, and Fiume, as well as Italian-annexed areas around Lubljana and Sisak, and island of Krk, formed into new German region of Adriatisches Küstenland administered by Raaber, Gauleiter of Carinthia.
