1. Speer was President of Central Planning Department as well as Minister for Armament Production. (13) This Department tabulated the need for labor in German industry, and if there were not enough German workers, established how many foreign workers had to be provided. (12) The occupied territories were divided into zones of operation or districts, some with military Governors, and some with civilian administration. "My duty, by order of the Fuehrer, was to satisfy my requirements for work people from these districts by requests to the appropriate military governors in the occupied territories." (12) Particularly anxious to obtain skilled workers from France and Belgium, and witness explains his methods. (16 - 17).
