<p>Particulars of the scope and functions of both Staff machines, of their essential component parts and chain of comd.</p>

<p>The combined powers of control of State Party and Armed Forces, vested in the single person of Adolf HITLER, confront the OKH. The methods of Party strife imported into the conflicts between the OKW and OKH. The field of work of the C in C, Army, is progressively restricted (characteristic examples: OKW theatres of war, administration of occupied territories). Interference of the OKW in the command of the Military Forces. Elimination of OKH in political-military problems (BALKANS, etc.).</p>	
IV. <u>OKW and OKH from the Assumption of the Army Command by HITLER up to Sep 42</u>	" 145-176
<p>The division of work in the OKH. Chain of command. Alterations in the structure of the OKW (BUHLE, Tpt and Signals). Divergences between the Army General Staff and the OKW in the appreciation of the situation, the conduct of operations and questions of Army organization, up to Sep 42. Allied forces administered by the OKW.</p>
