MEMORANDUM THROUGH COLONEL BRUNDAGE

FOR THE BOARD OF REVIEW

SUBJECT: Trial Brief on Defendant Streicher

There is transmitted herewith a preliminary trial brief on defendant Streicher. It should be pointed out that even considering all the evidence in connection with the project briefs, the case as it now stands against Streicher is not strong. When the author of this brief started work on Streicher, barely ten days ago, there was very little evidence processed and in the files of this office. Evidence has been located and some of it partially processed. There is additional cumulative evidence in this office which has not been processed at all.

The board of review has authorized the use of a Nurnberg attorney to locate possible witnesses who can be used against Streicher. It is suggested that a further search for documents as to Streicher be authorized. The NSDAP documents reported to be at Freising (see attached letter, Blumenstein) may be a fruitful source of evidence. It is thought that a stronger case can be developed quickly against Streicher by obtaining evidence of his conduct as Gauleiter.

The documents cited are enclosed in an envelope, in the order directed. Only one document has been translated. All documents cited will be fully translated and processed as rapidly as translation facilities permit.

An index will be transmitted on 12 November 1945.
