GENERAL

1. Guyon-Witzschel was interrogated at her own written request as to why she was being held in prison and particularly in solitary confinement. She was advised that one of the reasons was her failure to tell the truth in the course of her prior interrogation in which she had sworn that she had never met General Wolff. It is apparent from the notes passed between her and General Wolff that she has known the latter for some time and that they have numerous acquaintances in common.

2. Guyon-Witzschel again testified under oath that she had never met General Wolff; that she had never seen him until he arrived at the Nürnberg jail; that she had never spoken to him even there; and that she had conducted no correspondence of any kind with him. After some further discussion regarding her early life, she was dismissed with the suggestion that as long as she continued to lie, she would probably remain in jail.
