Reich Cabinet, Leadership Corps of the Nazi Party,  
The SS, the SD, The Gestapo, The SA and Count One IV  
(D) 3 (f)

**TO :** The Board of Review

1. Pursuant to paragraph 2, Board of Review Memorandum No. 1, 26 October 1945, 25 copies of trial briefs on each of the above portions of the Indictment assigned to Section 6 (with the exception of the SS) have been submitted to Lt. Col. Ben Kaplan. These briefs were prepared, respectively by the lawyers whose signatures appear thereon. The brief on the SS will be completed before the end of the day.

2. Document books are necessarily incomplete. As soon as mimeographed translations are received the Statement of Evidence can be finally re-checked against these translations, the documents completed, and the briefs re-dated.

3. The Presentation Branch of Special Projects Division is engaged, in cooperation with the officers of this section, in preparing for use at the trial one or more enlarged charts for each organization. In addition thereto, photographic enlargements of the "Coffin Chart" (attached to 2273-PS, p. 31, of the SD and Gestapo Brief by Lt. Harris) and of the Chart "Inclusion of the German Citizen in the National Socialist Structure and Path to Political Leadership" (2833-PS, attached as Appendix A to Brief on Count One IV (D) 3 (f) by Lt. Bone) are recommended by this section for panel display at the trial.

4. It is desired to emphasize that personnel in Section 6 have worked day and night on these briefs; the girls have spent long hours in continuous night and Sunday work. All deserve the highest commendation for the excellent spirit manifested and for the progress made.
