I have learned that Schacht had two assistants in the Reichsbank who are now in the Deutsche Bank in Hamburg. Their names are Focke and Hulse. I hear the British have employed them to take some part in Military Government.

Lt. Meltzer tells me that he believes these men were questioned by Bernstein's people but not by his. They may be worth questioning.

I advise you of this because I understand that within the approval of the Chief of Counsel your committee has complete charge of the preparation of the case, including selection of witnesses.

Accordingly I will see that you are kept informed of all pertinent matters coming to my attention.
