

To be called together at Nuremberg for mutual consultation:
from Berlin:

Dr. Otto LENZ, Attorney-at-law in Berlin-Charlottenburg,
Schlenerstr. 39.

Lenz was formerly in the Reich Ministry of Justice, from which he resigned because he did not wish to be connected with Gertner's policies and because, from the very beginning, he was opposed to the National Socialist regime. He then became a lawyer. He shared his law offices with attorney Dr. Etschelt, who lost his life at Flossenbürg and who was a friend of General Halder.

Good source of information. Condemned to four years in penitentiary.

Dr. SCHUSTER

at present, in all likelihood at Hessisch-Lichtenau near Kassel, Hopfelderstr. 1, care of Sander.

Might have to be requested through the Ministerial Collecting Center Fwerstenhagen.

Schuster was with the Reichspostministerium.

Well informed with regard to the internal relationship between political leaders and military authority. He was a confidant in official circles (Ministerial). He obtained valuable information via telephone censorship.

Dr. Hans GLOBKE, Hessisch-Lichtenau near Kassel, Hopfelderstr. 1, care of Sander.

At present working at Ministerial Collecting Center Fwerstenhagen.

We have received very valuable information from him, concerning confidential sessions of decisive leadership councils (Fuehrungsausschüssen), some of which were presided over by Goering.

Jakob KAISER, Berlin-Wilmersdorf, Wittelsbachstr. 6,
formerly a leader of the Christian Trade
Union (guild); during the war an active
anti-Nazi in cooperation with military
opposition.

Dr. KOPPEN Berlin-Wilmersdorf, Pommersche Str. 16,
formerly an official stenographer at the
Bavarian Landtag (provincial diet), later
in similar position with the Reich Ministry
of Interior, and finally as a stenographer
with the People's Court. Information con-
cerning the conduct of the People's Court
in general and individual trials in
particular.

For cooperation we furthermore suggest:

The Protestant prison chaplain, Pöelchau, at present at
Frochsess, Bendorf near Hofheim.

The Catholic prison chaplain, Heinrich Krentzberg, at
present at Wuppertal-Barmen, Brunhildenstr. 41.

In their work as prison chaplains, both have been able to
get a clear picture of court martial procedure and other
penal prosecution. It is to be expected that both will
be able to furnish information concerning the extent and
intensity of the National Socialist terror within the
established framework of justice.

If at all possible, the following should also be brought
here:

Frau von Dohnanyi, Christine, (sister of Pastor Dietrich
Benhefer, related to the Bishop of
Chichester), wife of the private
secretary of Canaris and in possession
of valuable information through her
husband. At present occupied at
putting this information into writing.
Present address: Salema, Bodensee.

Baroness Elisabeth von Gottenberg, wife of Karl Ludwig
Count von Gottenberg on the directing
staff of Counterintelligence. The notes

deposited by G-ttenberg should be obtained. With regard to Baroness G-ttenberg, contact should be established with the wife of Admiral Gebhart, with whom Canaris had frequent political talks.

To be brought from the Rhineland if possible:

Dr. Paul FRANKEN from Bonn (Rhine).

He has fought National Socialism from the very beginning and was imprisoned for several years.

Dr. Alois BECKER, Oberregierungsrat at Koblenz; probably at present at the monastery Walberberg, Köln.

Regarding persecution of churches:

Contact on the Catholic side:

Prince Archbishop Dr. Andreas ROHRACHER, Salzburg (cf. letter).

Through Vicar-general PRANGE, Berlin, probably living at the Hedwig Hospital, with

Bishop Konrad von PREYSING, Berlin (contact Lt. D.D. Clark, USNR, Civ. Adm. Div., COMUS, APO 742), and with

Bishop von GALEN, Münster (Westphalia).

also from the Rhineland:

Dr. SIEMER, Father Superior of the Dominican Order at Walberberg, near Köln.

and from the Protestant side:

Rev. LILJE and Rev. BEFHGE, both of Berlin;

for Southern Germany with Landesbischof WURM, stuttgart.

It is also suggested that a member of the sect, Jehovah's Witnesses (Bibelforscher) be called upon,

Paul WAUER, at present at Wall, near Miesbach, Obb., care of Andreas Stoib, Ableiten.

He is a very simple man, but a convinced and fighting believer who spent many years in various concentration camps.

From the Jewish side I have one suggestion:

Suggestion of a Jewish man: I am thinking of the leader of the Bauhaus Committee, Finkelstein, Munich, Rauchstrasse 2, who has spent 5 years in concentration camps and is in possession of a wealth of material.

Concerning GORING, the following man should be questioned: Dr. Hans SCHAUDIG, physician in Regensburg and a friend of Goring's aide-de-camp, Bodenschatz.

Concerning HESS: Count von Tenchert, Munich, Kopernikus-
str. 1. According to von Tenchert, Hess' political
backroom connection with England (Baldwin's
daughters) was Dr. Gerl, physician in Hindelang/
Allgäu.

Tenchert will furthermore prepare a statement
concerning the case of Gamleiter Adolf Wagner
and accomplices, a case of corruption involving
many millions.
