MEMORANDUM TO MAJOR GENERAL DONOVAN

Subject: Request for Papers from Document Room

1. Attached are copies of the analysis sheets which you requested. The only request not filled is for an analysis sheet of document 1061-PS, "Report on the Extermination of Jews in the Warsaw Ghetto". This will be forwarded to you as soon as it is completed.

2. The Danish material of which you spoke is in the process of translation and copies will be forwarded to you as soon as it is completed. We expect to have it completed within the next two days.

3. A photostatic copy of document number 1382-PS is being prepared and will be forwarded to you as soon as it is finished.

4. Transmitted herewith are copies of the translation of some of the documents which you requested. The balance of the documents are either not translated, in the process of translation, or translated with only one copy now in our files. Those not translated will be translated if you desire. Copies of those in the process of translation will be forwarded to you when completed. Those of which we have only one copy may be borrowed on receipt from the Document Room or will be reproduced if you wish. At the present time, because of our limited translating facilities, we normally translate or reproduce translations of only those documents which will probably be introduced in evidence at the trial.
